

Guidelines for the first post-lockdown worship services:

Consider your health and that of others!

1. Please follow directions of the ushers/greeters for entering and seating.
2. Please do not attend the service if you are not feeling well or have had a cough, cold, or elevated temperature recently.
3. Please take your temperature on a few days prior to the service date to confirm it is normal.
4. Please consider staying at home if you have an underlying health condition or are considered "vulnerable" to the effects of Covid-19. Live streaming of the service will be available.

1. Pre-service cleaning of surfaces (handrails, doors, etc.) will be conducted
2. Hand cleaners will be available in various locations, but there should be little reason to touch things
3. Masks will be expected to be worn while entering, exiting, singing, or moving around for all who can tolerate them. Masks may be removed while seated.
Seating accommodation will be available in the fellowship room for those with conditions that prevent wearing masks.
Masks will be available at church for those that don't have one.
4. Scriptures will be included on the screen. If you prefer, you may bring your own Bible.
5. Arriving worshipers will be escorted into the building individually or by family/living group to assure spacing. (Outside greeters, no personal contact)
6. Entrance doors will be held open or propped open by outside greeters
7. Entrance through Lovers Lane doors for those planning to sit in the back ½ of the church or through the parking lot doors for those planning to sit in the front part of the church or fellowship room (using TV participation)
8. Assistance/guidance provided inside to seating location with planned spacing by ushers/"hall monitors". We will observe a minimum of 6 foot spacing at all times.
9. Seating will be in alternating (every 2nd) pews at each end, assuring that groups remain separated appropriately in the middle of the pew
10. Worshippers will be dismissed/escorted from the building after the service by group to assure adequate spacing
11. Socializing is welcomed in the parking lot, remembering to use masks and maintain spacing.

Other notes:

Mutual welcome will not take place or will only be hand waving

Offering plates will not be passed (as has been the case just prior to ceasing of public worship). The plates will be located by the doors for your use.

No coffee/refreshments will be available (for the first week or 2).

Nursery will not be provided, however, please bring your children if you feel comfortable doing so. We want to see as many of our church family as possible!

The library will not be open.
